Track Your Reading History

Four-County Library System now offers a way to keep a history of your checkouts. You must opt-in on your account page on the online catalog to activate it.

- Sign in to your account & go to "My Account"
- Go to "Personal Information" then "Preferences"
- Check the boxes to "Record my checkout history" and "Show my checkout history"

Note: The history will not include anything before you opted in. If your library card expires this will delete your history. If a book is discarded from the system it will be deleted from your history list. All library records are confidential by N.Y. State law. Your history list will not be sold or offered to a 3rd party.
